WEIGH-IN STATIONS

Please be patient at weigh-in stations. Some have businesses to run and all are helping us and you out.

Competitors with fish to weigh at the Cape Egmont Boat Club on the final day, Sunday 12th November, must be at the official weigh-in area by 5:00 p.m.

LEADER BOARD UPDATES

A provisional leader board will be updated during the contest. Check the TOSC website for details.

Only qualifying fish will be listed. That is, one fish, per species, per competitor.

Competitors may be disqualified for breach of the rules. **See rule 22 below.** Therefore, a few fish just outside the prize money, will also be listed. If in doubt, weigh it in.

If we are unable to update the website, the provisional leader board will be sent via email, once a day between 7pm and 11pm. NOTE:- Email addresses will not be updated during the week of the TOSC (Monday 6th to Sunday 12th).

RULE 22

Any competitor who wishes to lay a complaint against another competitor, for breach of the rules, must do so in writing before 5:00 p.m. Sunday 12th November 2017. The organisers reserve the right to withhold prize money and may introduce outside parties to investigate any such breach.

SERIOUS RULE BREACHES INCLUDE:

Using a surf ski, surf board, swimmer, kontiki, kite, torpedo, drone, canoe, kayak, boat, bait mortar, cannon, etc. to take lines out or propel bait or burley.

Fishing outside the boundary, during the hours of the contest.

Fishing, on Wednesday 8 November 2017, before 6:00 p.m. That includes fishing for bait. If you see another competitor fishing before the official start time, please inform them of their "error". In the event of non-compliance, contact the organiser as soon as possible.

Take a photo if possible.
